

Compliance Dismissals

Compliances (Correction of the violation) must be done prior to the appearance date on your citation, which is “within 10 days of the date of the citation.”

No Insurance	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Show Proof that you had insurance on the Date/time of violation from Insurance Company Proof must identify either you by name or the vehicle listed on the citation. 	None
No License Plate or Only One	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Show registration that was current on the date/time of violation Both plates must be on the vehicle when you come to Court. Registration must identify the same vehicle as listed on the citation Submit affidavit of compliance. 	\$10
Display Altered, Unclean or Obscured License Plates	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bring pictures of front & back plates on the same vehicle as listed on the citation Sign an affidavit at court that this violation has been corrected. 	\$10
Fail to Display Driver's License	Show proof that your driver license was valid on the date/time of violation for the type of vehicle you were driving	\$10
Defective Equipment* (or in unsafe condition)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Provide proof that the defect was corrected (see list below) Proof must identify the same vehicle as listed on the citation and for the violation listed This dismissal does NOT apply to commercial vehicles. 	\$10
Violate DL Restriction	Driver's license endorsement was imposed because of a physical condition that was surgically or otherwise medically corrected before the date of the offense, or in error & that is established by the defendant; and the Dept of Public Safety removes the restriction or endorsement before the first court appearance	\$10
Expired Driver License	Show proof that you renewed your driver license on or before the appearance date on your citation	\$20
Fail to Change Name or Address on License	Show proof that you went to the Texas Dept of Public Safety & got your address or name corrected on or before the appearance date on your citation	\$20
Expired Vehicle Registration	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Show proof of registration of vehicle with payment of late registration fee to county assessor-collector Proof must identify the same vehicle as citation 	\$20
Expired Disabled Parking Placard	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Show proof of renewal of Disabled Parking Placard Disabled parking placard must match your Driver License 	\$20

***Some Defective Equipment Violations** (This list is the most common offenses and should not be considered comprehensive): Brakes, Exhaust Emission system, Head lamps (lights), Headlight beam indicator, License Plate Lamp, Mirror violation, Muffler, Obstructed view through window(s), stop lamps, tail lamps, sunscreening device, TV/video improperly located, Turn signals, windshield wipers ...
