

Andrews MSW Landfill

Safety Rules

1. **If you have, or observe, an emergency, please notify a landfill employee and call 9-1-1 at once.**
2. **Safety first!** Anyone behaving in an unsafe or unprofessional manner will be required to leave the landfill.
3. **All persons and vehicles enter the Landfill at their own risk.** The City of Andrews assumes no liability for bodily injury, personal injury, or property damage while on Landfill property.
4. All children, pets, and adults not involved in unloading of refuse shall remain inside the vehicle at all times. Children under 15 and pets are not permitted within 30 feet of the edge of cell / pit.
5. Watch where you are stepping at all times to avoid injuries from trips, falls, punctures, cuts, rattle snake bites, etc.
6. Cell phone use is prohibited while on the scales and during the operation of a vehicle or any equipment within the boundaries of the Landfill.
7. Smoking is not permitted within the Landfill boundaries.
8. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not permitted. Obviously intoxicated or impaired customers will not be permitted to enter the facility.
9. Restricted materials shall not be disposed of in any portion of the Landfill.
10. All vehicles are subject to random inspection by Landfill personnel and/or law enforcement.
11. Obey all posted traffic and speed limit signs. At the gate, scales and scale house area, the speed limit is 10 mph. Speed limit from scales area to cell / pit area is 20 mph.
12. Approach the edge of cells / pits with extreme caution. Regardless whether in a vehicle, or on foot, respect these precarious locations. Refer to safety rule #3.
13. Be aware of moving landfill equipment and other vehicles and maintain safe following distance. Utilize the proper side of the roadway at all times. Do not pass moving vehicles.
14. Landfill equipment operators have the right of way on the active disposal area. All vehicles must yield to operating machinery and to pedestrians.
15. **In the event of a collision or spill** of petroleum product notify Landfill personnel. Do not move vehicles involved in a collision or spill until asked to do so by emergency responders or facility manager. The driver or their employer will be required to clean up and remove spilled materials.
16. Any unattended vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense unless authorized by expressed written consent of the facility manager or their designee.
17. The City of Andrews assumes no liability for damage to vehicles resulting from towing or otherwise assisting disabled vehicles.
18. No repairs or maintenance to customers' vehicles are to be performed on City of Andrews' property without expressed written consent by the facility manager or their designee.
19. **UNAUTHORIZED SCAVENGING AND SALVAGING IS PROHIBITED.**
20. Unauthorized access is not permitted outside of posted operating hours.
