JUROR'S RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Right to Reemployment: A private employer may not terminate the employment of a permanent employee because the employee serves as a juror. An employee whose employment is terminated in violation of this section is entitled to return to the same employment that the employee held when summoned for jury service if the employee, as soon as practical after release from jury service, gives the employer actual notice that the employee intends to return (Civil Practice and Remedies code, Section 122.001).

Failure to Answer Summons and Penalties: A person who fails to comply with this Summons is subject to a contempt action punishable by a fine of not more than \$100 (Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 45.026 and Government Code, Section 21.002). Additionally, a person shall be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 if the person: (1) fails to attend court in obedience to the notice without reasonable excuse; or (2) files a false claim of exemption from jury service (Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 45.027).

Proper Clothing Required: All persons entering the courtroom should be dressed in clothing reasonably befitting the dignity and solemnity of the court proceedings.

Exempt or Disqualified: You do need to appear in person if you are exempt or not qualified for jury service. To claim an exemption or report your disqualification you must complete the following form below, sign it, and personally bring it immediately to the address printed on the front of this summons.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR JURY SERVICE (Gov't Code, Section 62.102)	EXEMPTIONS FROM JURY SERVICE* (Gov't Code, Section 62.106)
<p>To serve as a juror you must meet qualifications:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be at least 18 years of age; 2. Be a citizen of this state & a resident of the City of Andrews; 3. Be qualified under the Constitution & laws to vote in the County in which you are to serve as a juror (<i>Note: you DO NOT have to be a Registered Voter to be qualified to vote.</i>); 4. Be of sound mind and good moral character; 5. Be able to read and write; 6. Not have served as a juror for six days during the preceding three months in the municipal or county courts or during the preceding six months in the district court; 7. Not have been convicted of theft or any felony; and 8. Not be under indictment or other legal accusation of a misdemeanor theft, felony theft or any other felony charge. 	<p>You <i>may</i> be excused from jury service if:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You are over 70 years of age; 2. You have legal custody of a child or children younger than 10 years of age and service on the jury would require leaving the child or children without adequate supervision; 3. You are a student at a public or private high school; 4. You are enrolled and attend college; 5. You are an officer or an employee of the senate, house of representatives, or any department, commission, board, office or other agency in the legislative branch of state government; 6. You are the primary caretaker of a person who is an invalid, unable to care for himself or herself (This exemption does not apply to health care workers); 7. <u>This questionnaire was addressed for someone that is deceased</u> <p>*You are not <u>required</u> to claim an exemption. It is your choice.</p>
