

ORDINANCE 1416

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1341, PRESCRIBING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE CITY OF ANDREWS, TEXAS, FOR GARBAGE AND RUBBISH COLLECTION AND LANDFILL USE, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDREWS, TEXAS:

Section 1: That from and after the passage and effective date of this ordinance, Ordinance 1341 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Garbage and rubbish collection and landfill fees payable to the City are established as follows:

<u>1. RESIDENTIAL RATES</u>

(shared container, 2-day pickup) Small stores less than 2,000 sq. ft., one or two person office, home & business in house or on same residential lot, barber or beauty shop, gas kiosk, car wash, individual doctor's office, day care with 12 children or less

<u>3. COMMERCIAL RATE II</u>			
(shared container, 2-day pickup) Regular stores, multiple staff offices, laundries, cleaners, motels with less than 25 units, auto repair shops, day care with more than 12 children

<u>4. COMMERCIAL RATE III</u>			
(shared container, 4-day pickup) Cafes, convenience stores, banks, motels with 25 or more units

(shared container, 4-day pickup) Large stores, offices and manufacturing over 5,000 sq. ft., lumber yards, schools, hospitals, medical clinics, factories – 1 st container. Additional containers @ Rate 6 – special accounts

<u>6. SPECIAL ACCOUNTS</u>			
If a customer has special conditions that require a special container location, size, or service, the following rates will be charge.

7. OTHER FEES

Fees will be charged at the landfill as follows:

A. Definitions

Tire—a relatively intact passenger, light truck, truck or implement tire.

Tire Part—Tire rubber resulting from shredding, slicing, chipping or quartering of tires.

B. Origin of Waste. The use of the City of Andrews Landfill is restricted to those persons and businesses operating and/or living in Andrews County. Only waste originating from activities in Andrews County may be disposed of in the City Landfill, including tires or tire parts.

C. A customer of the City of Andrews may dispose of waste and/or debris, but not tires or tire parts, at the Municipal Landfill at no charge. The customer must present a City of Andrews utility bill showing landfill and collection charges along with a picture ID; both the utility bill and the ID must show the same name.

D. Because of the 20 ton per day limit, private sanitation packer trucks will not be allowed to dump at the City of Andrews Landfill.

E. Brush and limbs (not contaminated with other debris or garbage) may be dumped without charge as long as the State does not require brush to count toward the tonnage limit.


F. Texas Railroad Commission Regulated Waste must comply with TRRC and TCEQ permit requirements and will be charged 3 times the regular tonnage rate with a \$250.00 minimum.

Section 2. In the event any commercial user chooses to haul their own garbage, then such user shall first obtain a permit from the city to be approved by the City Council before hauling their own garbage and pay the landfill charges prescribed by the Council.


Section 3. All other provisions of Sections 34-42 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Andrews, Texas and Ordinance Nos. 705, 877, 947, 1084, 1112, 1091, 1111, 1120, 1125, 1198, 1248, 1302 and 1341 of the City of Andrews, Texas that are not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
