

**ORDINANCE NO. 1443**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1376, PRESCRIBING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE CITY OF ANDREWS, TEXAS, FOR DOMESTIC AND INDUSTRIAL SEWER SERVICE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDREWS, TEXAS:**

Section 1. That from and after the passage and effective date of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 1376 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(A) Sewer fees payable to the City are established as follows:

<u>TYPE OF SERVICE</u>	<u>CHARGE</u>
<b>RESIDENTIAL RATES</b> – residents and mobile homes (per unit)	12.50 (eff 3/1/10)
<b>APARTMENTS</b> (per unit using common sewer line)	10.00
<b>SMALL BUSINESS</b> – retail or single office	12.50
<b>BUSINESSES</b> (more than 10 employees and more than 2 restrooms – a lot of public access)	13.50
<b>GROCERY STORES</b>	14.00
<b>CAFES/BAKERIES</b>	20.00
<b>SERVICE STATIONS:</b>	
Vehicle wash facility (drive through/coin operated)	20.00
Full service stations with wash rack	17.50
Convenience store with gas pump	17.50
Self-service gas pump only (no convenience store)	12.50
<b>LAUNDRIES</b>	38.00
<b>TAILOR SHOPS/DRY CLEANERS</b>	15.00

**HOTELS, MOTELS, HOSPITALS, NURSING HOMES, ASSISTED LIVING, SCHOOLS**


1 to 10 rooms	21.50
11 to 20 rooms	32.00
21 to 30 rooms	42.50
31 rooms and above	51.50

(B) The industrial sewer service monthly charge shall be \$45.50 for the first 200m gallons of water consumed by the customer each month. The charge shall increase by 19¢ per 1,000 gallons of water consumed by the customer each month in addition to the first 200,000 gallons.


Section 2. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance is to be in effect with billings mailed after March 1, 2010.
